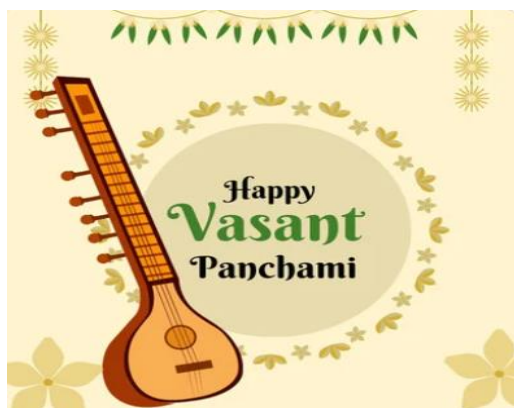

(8th March, 2026 is Sunday)

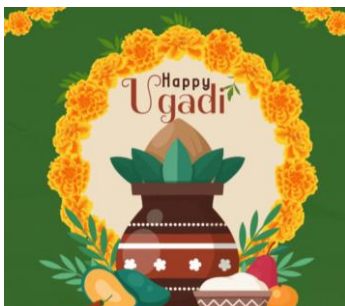
Our school celebrated Women's Day with inspiring activities honoring women. Students shared performances promoting equality and empowerment.

Students engage in activities like speeches, dramatics, and creative exhibits. It celebrates the richness and versatility of the English language.

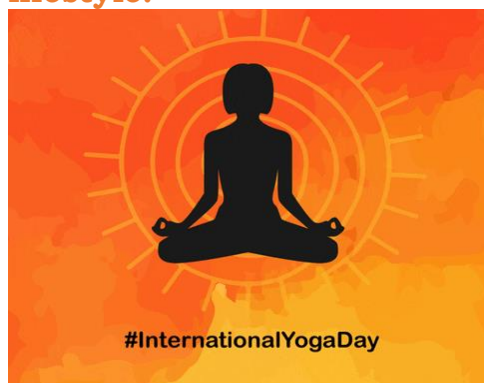
To enhance language skills and cultural appreciation.

To promote confidence and creativity in communication.

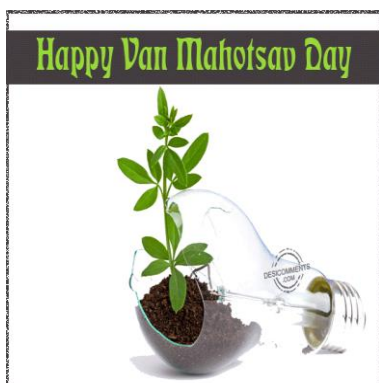

Independence Day celebrations : 15th August 2026

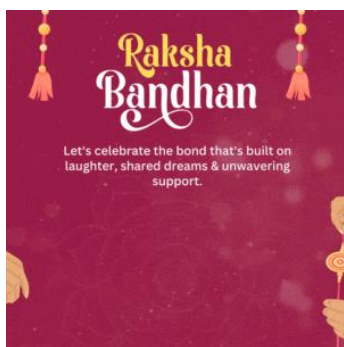
Independence Day celebrations in school honour India's freedom with patriotic activities. Students learn the value of national pride.

Raksha Bandhan celebrations: 27th August 2026

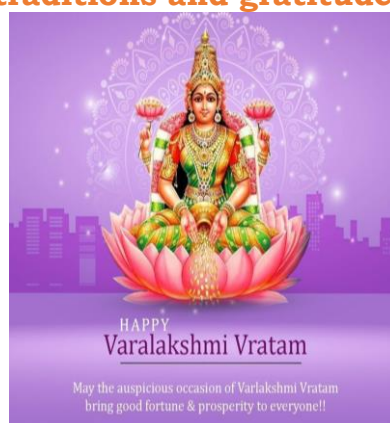

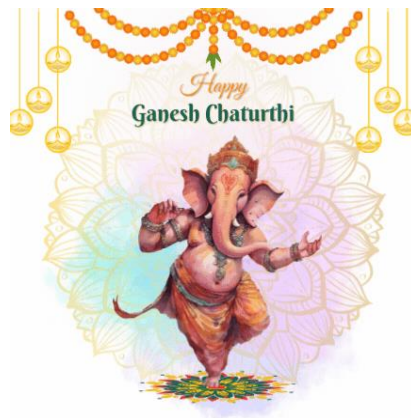

Students create clay items as a part of Diwali celebrations. It provides a fun blend of art and cultural tradition.

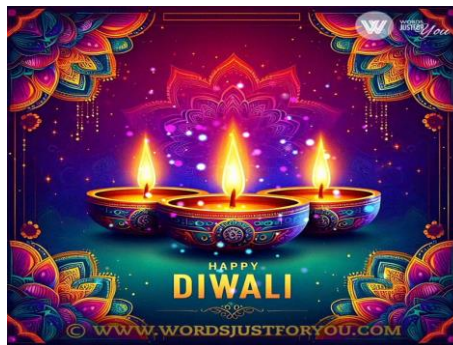

It brings the entire school community together in joy and pride.

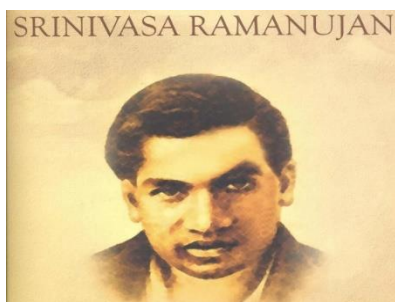

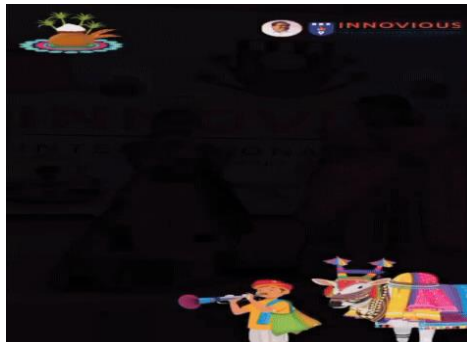

Sankranthi celebrations – 13th Jan 2027

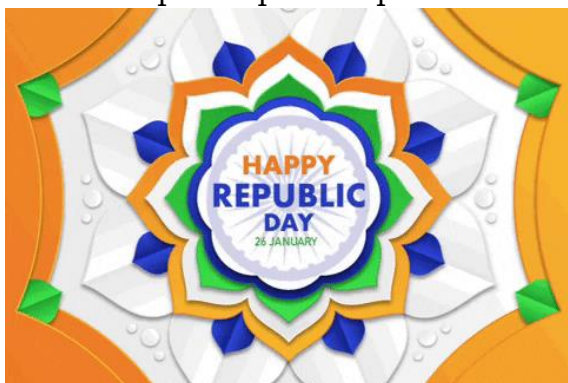
Sankranthi is a harvest festival that gives thanks for the crops and celebrates the hard work of farmers. It is a time of joy, gratitude, and traditional celebrations.
